FEES: There has been no change in the fee structure of the school tuition fees and the payment for the new academic year will be the same as last year. **Fee Slips can be collected from the Accounts Office when you come on the 12th Feb. to leave your son in the boarding.**

HOBBIES & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: It is our endeavour that in the new academic year we will be able to introduce more hobbies and co-curricular activities. Hopefully we will be able to add an NCC wing during the course of the Cyear. We hope to add **ELECTRONICS** for the senior students and **QUILLING, THREAD WORK, PAPER CUTS etc for the middle and junior classes. The Electronic Kit for classes IX and X will cost Rs 2000/- parents who wish their child to be a part of the Electronic Hobby should add this amount in their poc account and inform the school of wanting to be a part of the same.**

Just a few points to keep in mind as we are getting ready to starting the new academic year in St. Mary's.

- The new school year begins on the 13th Feb. **Boarders will have to return to school on the 12th Feb. between 1:30 and 3:30 pm**
- Kindly bring along the two forms: **1. The Health Profile 2023** (available on the school website) of your child. Kindly let us know the complete medical history of your child. He will be with us for the next few months and it is important that we know his complete medical details, esp. in case there is a medical emergency that we have to deal with. Kindly ensure that he has taken the recommended injections.

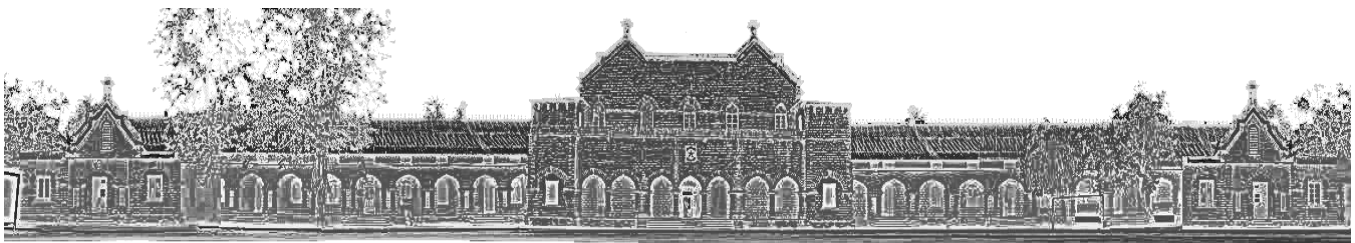
Kindly bring a coloured laminated Aadhar Card of your child, the size of a credit/debit card. This is required if and when your child visits Global Hospital for his medical needs

2. The complete Details Sheet 2023 of your child.

3. Anti-Bullying Statement & Contract

The HARD COPIES of the same must be brought and given to the New Boarding-In-Charge, in the School Office.

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- When you bring your child to school on the 12th Feb. Kindly collect the **SCHOOL CALENDER SHEET**. This will give you the details of the school program for the year. Kindly note his holiday dates will be given and it is expected that the parents strictly follow the dates of arrival and departure of the various holidays.
- **Please note:** Your child is in the boarding and it is not possible for him to attend various family functions and weddings, house warming etc. Please note that he will not be allowed extension of home visits. On certain days parents will be permitted to visit your sons in the school campus itself. On such visits, students will not be allowed to leave the campus. You can share home made food with your child in the campus itself.
- **Receiving of Tuck will be permitted only on certain days as will be specified in the SCHOOL CALENDER FORM.** No tuck or other items will be permitted outside of the days specified in the calender.
- If your child is not going to continue in St. Mary's for the next academic year, kindly make an applicate for TC. If application for TC has been requested after the 31st January, 2023, then a month's fee (Boarding & Tuition) will be charged in lieu of notice. If TC is requested in the months to follow, then the rules as given in the Fee Slips, the Diary and the Parent's Information sheet will apply.
- Class IX students please note that the English Text Book has been changed. Instead of doing Merchant of Venice, you will be doing **Julius Caesar** this year.
- Presently it is very cold in Mt, Abu and the winter conditions are expected to stretch well into the month of March this year as per the weather report. Kindly bring enough warm clothes and blankets when you join school in Feb. The days are quite warm, though the nights tend to be quite cold. Using Muffler and monkey caps and an extra blanket are highly recommended.

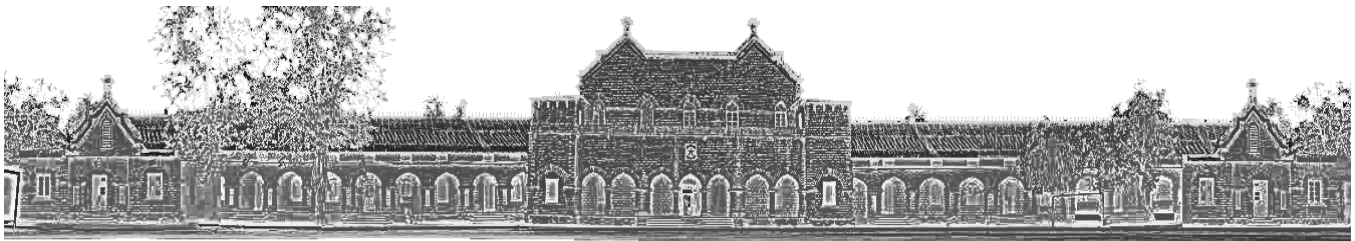

BULLYING CONTRACT

We students of St. Mary's School agree to work together to stop bullying in our school.

Bullying is defined as intentionally aggressive behaviour that can take many forms (verbal, physical, social/relational/emotional, or cyber bullying— or any combination of these; it involves an imbalance of power, and is often repeated over a period of time. The bullying can consist of one child bullying another, a group of children ganging up against one lone child, or one group of kids targeting another group.

Common behaviours attributed to bullying include put-downs, name calling, rumours, gossip, verbal threats, menacing, harassment, intimidation, social isolation or exclusion, and physical assaults.

We believe that no student deserves to be bullied and that every student regardless of race, colour, religion, nationality, size, gender, popularity, athletic, academic, or social ability, or intelligence has the right to feel safe, secure, and respected.

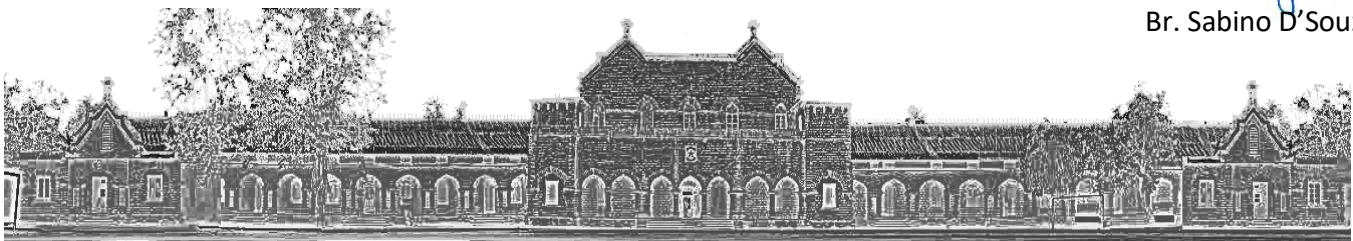
